It gives us immense pleasure that, IQAC of our college has organized NAAC sponsored a two-day National seminar on *NAACs Revised Accreditation Framework and Quality Improvement Strategies in Higher Education*. The main objective of this seminar was to explore the various themes and concepts related to revised accreditation process and to understand the new guidelines, to create awareness and provide information and insights regarding the mechanisms involved in IQAC and NAAC process. The well-known personalities in the field of assessment and accreditation process were called as resource persons. Registration for the workshop started at 9.30 am followed by Inaugural function and then technical sessions. All the technical sessions were run as per schedule.

In all 74 participants attended the workshop. These included principals, IQAC coordinators, faculty members and officials from various colleges. Selected 09 research articles presented by participants in the seminar.

Day –I : 20/12/2019

Inaugural Session :

Dr. S. D. Gaikwad Assistant coordinator of, IQAC welcomed all the guests and participants. The session was presided over by Hon. Adv. Bhimraoji Dhonde, Founder President of Anand Charitable Sanstha Ashti. Dist. Beed. The session was inaugurated with the auspicious hands of Dr. M. D. Jahagirdar, NAAC Assessor, Bengaluru. The session was also graced by Prin. Dr. P. R. Gaikwad, Ex. Director, Higher Education , Maharashtra State,, Prin. Dr. H. G. Vidhate Principal of our college and Member of Management Council, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University Aurangabad.

IQAC Coordinator Dr. B. S. Khaire welcomed all the distinguished guests and briefed the participants about the objective and rationale of the seminar. He informed that the main objective of this seminar is to explore the various themes and concepts related to revised accreditation and to create awareness and insights regarding the mechanisms involved in IQAC and NAAC process.

Principal of our college and member of Management Council, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad Dr. H. G. Vidhate extended his gratitude to all resource persons and participants. He mentioned the benefits for college after successful assessment and accreditation by NAAC.

Technical Session –I

Prin. Dr. N. S. Rathi Chaired first technical session. The resource person Dr. Mahaling Dongare, Professor, S. M. Joshi College, Pune presented on Revised Accreditation Framework of NAAC. He explained minute details about the changes in new Assessment and Accreditation process. He discussed the changes introduced in the revised A & A process Framework. He explained all the seven criteria to serve as basis for assessment of HEIs in detail. All the key indicators were explained with suitable examples. He insisted on the benefits of accreditation and the systematic process to sustain quality and how benchmarking should be integrated into the fundamental operations of the Institutions.

Technical Session -II

The post lunch session was chaired by Dr. S. R. Nimbore, Principal , ASC college Ashti. Resource person Dr. M. M. Betkar, Principal, Shri Kumarswami Mahavidyalaya, AUSA. District Latur deliberated upon Patent Obtaining & Intellectual Property Rights. He told that intellectual property is the product of human intellect including creativity concepts, inventions, models symbols etc. whereas patent is an exclusive right granted by law to an inventor. He explained difference between Copyright, Patent and Trademark. He focused on Patents Act, 1970. He also highlighted about how to apply for patent, where to apply, how to register, procedure of filling patent application, eligibility criteria for getting Patent, essential documents to be submitted for patent obtaining etc.

Technical Session -III

The last session of first day was kept for Selected Papers Reading by delegates and it was chaired by Dr. D. T. Wagh, Principal of Bhagwan College Ashti. In this session 09 participants presented their research papers. Then followed question answer session.

Day –II : 21/12/2019

Technical Session –IV

The day second started with the technical session IV of resource person Dr. M. D. Jahagirdar. He discussed upon the Role of Internal Quality Assurance Cell in Quality improvement strategies in HIEs. He flagged certain important points regarding the IQAC. He focused upon the working principle of IQAC, its functions, benefits, composition, IQAC meeting, Record keeping, implementation of Best practices in institutions of higher education , Quality Management System (QMS), Digitization of Quality Assurance activities, outcome etc. At the discussion and interaction, participants raised their questions and sought clarification on issues relating IQAC. The session was chaired by Prin. Dr. P. R. Gaikwad, Ex Director Higher Education Pune.

Technical Session –V

This technical session was chaired by Dr. Abhay Shinde, IQAC coordinator , Arts, Commerce and Science College, Ashti. Resource person Dr. Ramdas Pawar, Ramkrushna More Mahavidyalaya Akurdi, Pune deliberated upon Extension and Best Practices in HEI. He addressed the importance of the Best practices in HEIs. He stated that the Best practices run by institution should be in alignment with the overall Vision, Mission and Goals of institution and should be reflect with the uniqueness of HEI.

Technical Session –VI

This session was led by Dr. Shivanand Kshirsagar K. S. K. College Beed. The topic of his talk was Role of ICT in Teaching- Learning And Evaluation. He addressed need of ICT teaching learning process in higher education. The talk was indeed productive. Dr. B. M. Waghule was the chairperson.

Technical Session –VII

Post lunch Technical session discussed Submission of online AQAR & DVV and was led by Prin. Dr. V. P. Mali J. Watumull Sadhubella Girls College Ulhasnagar. He said that institutions Accredited by NAAC need to submit AQAR online. He also addressed guidelines for submission of online AQAR and Data verification and validation as per Revised Accreditation Framework. Prin. Alok Pawar Swaraj College of Computer Science Pune chaired this session. The concluding session resolved the doubts and queries of the delegates towards AQAR preparation and Submission.
